- Mechanical Couplers/Adapters:** Align two fiber connectors within a fixture for minimal loss .
- Fusion Splice Couplers:** Fuse fiber ends together for permanent, low-loss connections .
- Optical Splitters:** Divide one input signal into multiple outputs, commonly used in passive optical networks (PON), .
- Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM) Couplers:** Combine or separate signals of different wavelengths onto a single fiber .
- Star Couplers:** Distribute signals from one input to multiple outputs in a central point configuration .

How to Connect a Fiber Optic Coupler

Identify the Ports: Determine which port is the input and which are outputs. Some couplers are bidirectional, but directional couplers have designated input and output ports .

Clean the Connectors: Use fiber optic cleaning tools to remove dust or debris from the fiber ends to prevent signal loss.

Insert the Connectors: Align the fiber connectors with the coupler ports. The internal alignment sleeve ensures the fiber cores are precisely aligned for efficient light transmission .

Secure the Connection: Push the connectors fully into the coupler until they click or fit snugly. For duplex or quad adapters, ensure both fibers...
