

Fiber distribution box and splicing box

To connect a fiber distribution box and a fiber splicing box, route the fiber cables carefully, splice the fibers inside the splicing box, and then organize and terminate them in the distribution box for secure, low-loss connections. Understanding the Boxes

Fiber Distribution Box (Termination Box): Serves as the endpoint for incoming fibers, allowing connection to devices or patch cords. It organizes, protects, and terminates fibers, often at the user end in FTTH or data center setups.

Fiber Splicing Box (Splice Closure): Designed to join two fiber optic cables, creating a continuous light path. It houses fusion or mechanical splices and protects them from environmental factors.

Step-by-Step Connection Process
Install the Boxes: Mount the fiber distribution box and splicing box securely, either on a rack, wall, or pole, depending on the deployment scenario.

Route the Fiber Cables: Introduce the fiber cables into each box through the designated cable entry points. Use grommets or cable clamps to secure the cables and prevent stress or bending beyond the minimum bend radius (typically 30 mm for G.657 fibers).

Prepare Fibers for Splicing: Strip the fiber jacket and coating, clean the fiber ends with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol, and cleave the fibers to create smooth, perpendicular end faces.

Splice the Fibers: Inside the splicing box, align and join the fibers using either fusion splicing (welding fibers together) or mechanical splicing (using a connector to align fibers). Protect the splice with a sleeve or tray to prevent damage.

Organize and Store Excess Fiber: Coil any extra fiber in the splice tray or distribution box to avoid tension or bending. Use cable ties or movable clips to secure fibers along the routing path.

Terminate in the Distribution Box: Connect the spliced fibers to pigtails or adapters in the distribution box. This allows easy connection to patch cords or ONUs while maintaining low insertion loss (typically around 0.2 dB per connection).

Test the Connection: Verify signal integrity using an OTDR or power meter to ensure min...
