- Placement:** Position the ONT and router near power outlets in a dry, ventilated area, ideally with surge protection.
- Sequence:** Always power on the ONT first, then the router, to allow proper network registration.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables:** Cat6a or higher is recommended for multi-gigabit speeds to preserve fiber performance.
