

Fiber optic cable to two routers

If each router needs its own independent network (e.g., for separate apartments), request multiple public IP addresses from your ISP. Connect a high-speed switch to the ONT. Connect each router to a separate port on the switch. Configure point-to-point links and routing so that each router can manage its own subnet while sharing the fiber connection.
- Direct Connection Considerations**
Directly connecting two routers to the ONT is generally not recommended unless the ISP allows multiple IPs. Without proper configuration, both routers may compete for the single public IP, causing connectivity issues.

Best Practices

- Place the primary router centrally for optimal coverage.
- Ensure the secondary router supports the same frequency bands to prevent interference.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or higher) to maintain fiber speeds.
- Test network performance after setup to ensure both routers operate correctly and coverage is s...
