Specialized connectors like E2000 or MU may include protective shutters or compact designs for high-performance or space-limited applications.

Fiber Optic Light Sources To use a fiber optic connector with light, a compatible fiber optic light source is required. These devices inject light into the fiber for testing, troubleshooting, or decorative purposes:

- Visual Fault Locators (VFL):** Emit visible red light to detect breaks or faults in fiber cables.
- LED or Laser Light Sources:** Provide single-mode or multimode light at wavelengths like 1310 nm, 1550 nm, or 850 nm for testing insertion loss and continuity.
- Decorative Fiber Lighting:** RGB or white LED sources can illuminate fiber strands for aesthetic applications, such as star ceilings or signage. Most light sources come with adapters for LC, SC, ST, or FC connectors, ensuring compatibility with standard fiber types.
