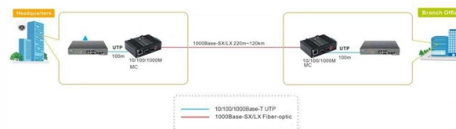


Fiber optic knotting for sensing



Overview

"Inspired by the topological mechanics of knots, we construct optical fiber knot (OFN) sensors for slip detection and friction measurement. In 2023, researchers turned submarine cables into earthquake warning systems and gave electric vehicles "optical nerves" to prevent battery failures. The low-index MgF₂ slab is adopted as the substrate. "Friction plays a critical role in dexterous robotic manipulation. Cost per sensing point over great distances cannot be matched by. Radiation absorption excites an orbital electron to a higher energy level. Heating the material enables the trapped states to interact with phonons and decay into lower-energy.
