.Applications ST-SC pigtails are used to bridge different connector types in a network, allowing seamless integration between legacy ST equipment and modern SC-based systems. They are suitable for:

- Single-mode (OS2) or multimode fibers
- Data centers, LANs, and telecom networks
- Fusion or mechanical splicing to trunk cables
