

Fixing of Conduit in Distribution Box

- Prepare the Box:** Ensure the box openings match the conduit size. Remove any burrs or sharp edges.
- Select the Correct Connector:** Match the connector to the conduit type and diameter (e.g., 1/2-inch FMC requires a 1/2-inch squeeze-type connector).
- Install the Connector:** Insert the conduit into the connector and tighten it. For LFMC, use a compression fitting to seal the jacket.
- Secure with Locknut:** Thread a locknut from inside the box onto the connector to hold it firmly. Locknuts also provide a low-resistance electrical bond for metallic conduits.
- Add Insulating Bushing:** Place a bushing inside the box over the connector to prevent conductor insulation from chafing against metal edges.
- Pull Conductors:** Insert the wires or cables through the conduit into the box. Ensure pulling wires are used if necessary to facilitate installation.
- Seal Unused Openings:** Close any unused box openings with masking tape or plugs to maintain safety and prevent debris entry.
- Check Alignment and Tighten:** Verify the conduit is properly aligned and all connections are secure.
