

Fixing of Ladder Cable Trays and Supports

Support spacing: Maximum distance between supports is typically 1.2 meters, with additional supports provided at bends, branches, and offsets. Suspended supports: Used for ceiling installations, ensuring the tray remains level and can carry the intended cable load. Alignment and Routing Routes should follow horizontal and vertical runs as per approved drawings. Maintain adequate clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance. Avoid cutting or drilling structural members without project approval. Ensure bends, T-pieces, and crossovers are properly supported to prevent stress on the tray and cables. Load Considerations Cable ladders are designed to support the weight of cables and any additional imposed loads such as equipment, wind, or ice. They are not intended for walking or supporting personnel. Always check that deflection limits are not exceeded and consult manufacturer specifications for maxi...
