

Four-phase wiring in the distribution box

- Wiring Sequence**
 - Incoming Supply:** Connect the four-phase supply to the main isolator or main breaker. Ensure each phase is clearly labeled.
 - Main Protection:** From the isolator, route each phase to the RCCB or main MCB for leakage and overcurrent protection.
 - Branch Distribution:** Connect each phase busbar to its respective branch MCBs. Each MCB protects a subcircuit and distributes power to the load.
 - Neutral and Earth:** Connect all neutral wires to the neutral bar and all protective earth wires to the earth bar. Ensure proper earthing to the ground rod or earth pit.
 - Outgoing Circuits:** Route wires from branch MCBs to the respective loads, maintaining neat cable management and avoiding crossing phases unnecessarily.
- Installation and Safety Practices**
 - Wire Binding:** Use plastic ties to keep wires organized and straight, maintaining uniform spacing.
 - Labeling:** Clearly mark each phase, neutral, and earth, as well as voltage levels and AC/DC distinctions if applicable.
 - Inspection:** Perform a thorough safety check for short circuits, overloads, and proper earthing before energizing the system.
 - Compliance:** Follow local electrical codes (IEC, NEC, or regional standards) for four-phase systems, including breaker ra...
