Wire Mesh (Cablofil) Trays Wire mesh trays are lightweight, flexible, and ideal for routing control, data, and fiber optic cables. They reduce installation time and allow easy cable management, while still providing proper grounding when metallic.

Materials

Steel: Strong and cost-effective, available in pre-galvanized, hot-dip galvanized, or stainless steel for indoor and outdoor applications.

Aluminum: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, suitable for indoor and outdoor use.

Stainless Steel: High corrosion resistance, ideal for harsh environments, including offshore installations.

Fiberglass (FRP/GRP): Non-metallic, corrosion-resistant, suitable for chemical or marine environments.

Grounding and NEC Compliance All metallic cable trays must be properly grounded and bonded according to NEC Article 392. Grounding ensures safety by preventing electrical shock and maintaining system reliability. Tray fill limits, cable separation, and firestop requirements must also be followed to comply with NEC standards.
