

HBA card connects to optical module

Fiber-Optic Cable: A compatible multimode fiber-optic cable must connect the HBA's SFP module to the target FC device, such as a storage array or FC switch.

Compatibility: The optical module and cable must match the specifications of the HBA and the connected device (e.g., multimode to multimode, correct wavelength, and supported speed).

Without an optical module and proper fiber connection, the HBA cannot establish a link or transmit data over the FC network. The HBA's LEDs will indicate no link if the SFP module is missing or the cable is not connected securely.

Summary In short, an HBA card alone cannot function for optical data transmission. It requires an SFP optical module installed in its FC port and a compatible fiber-optic cable connected to another FC device. This setup ensures proper signal conversion and communication between the server and storage infrastructure.
