

Household distribution box circuit breaker wiring terminals

- Earth/Ground Bar (PE):** All grounding wires from branch circuits and the main service ground wire are connected to this bar, providing a safe path for fault currents.

Wiring Practices

- Wire Color Coding:** Phase wires are typically yellow (A), green (B), and red (C) for three-phase systems; blue is used for neutral, and green/yellow for ground.
- Wire Size:** Select wire gauge according to circuit load. For lighting and standard outlets, 2.5 mm² is common; for air conditioning or heavy loads, 4 mm² may be used.
- Breaker Arrangement:** Breakers are usually arranged left to right, with reserved positions on the right side of the panel.
- Wiring Direction:** Incoming wires from the main breaker connect on the left side of branch breakers, while outgoing wires to circuits exit on the right.
