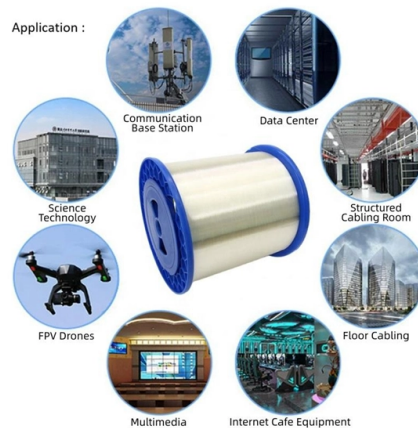


How long should the sleeve be left in the fiber optic cable junction box
