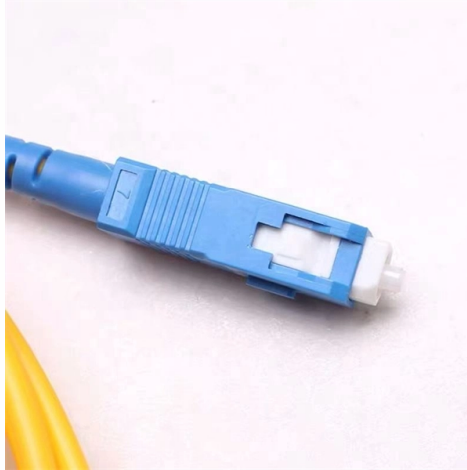


How many cores are in the junction box
