

How much does it cost to install fiber optic cables for surveillance cameras

- Indoor installation: \$1 to \$6 per linear foot for labor and termination.
- Complex routing: \$7 to \$12 per foot if running through walls, ceilings, or existing conduit.
- Aerial installation: \$8 to \$12 per foot using utility poles.
- Underground trenching: \$20 to \$50 per foot, depending on soil, distance, and urban complexity.
- Per-drop pricing: Each camera connection can cost \$250 to \$1,000 depending on routing and termination requirements.
