The operating voltage range typically spans 80% to 110% of the rated voltage, allowing continued operation during battery discharge, voltage ripple, or temporary deviations. Substation-grade switches compliant with IEC 61850-3 require manufacturers to specify quiescent and maximum load power consumption as well as inrush current at startup, which is critical for sizing auxiliary power systems correctly. Environmental and Thermal Considerations Power requirements are also influenced by environmental conditions. Industrial switches are designed to operate in extreme temperatures (-40°C to +75°C), with conformal coating for dust and moisture protection, and hardened against vibration, shock, and electrical noise. Proper thermal management is crucial; for example, modern switching power supplies require at least 20mm clearance on all sides and avoidanc...
