Rwanda has one of the highest fiber penetration rates relative to population in Africa. These terrestrial networks ensure that high-capacity international connectivity reaches urban centers and key economic corridors. Technical Capabilities Fiber optic cables transmit data using light, offering high-speed, low-latency, and high-volume data transmission far superior to copper or satellite connections. Single-mode fibers are used for long-distance communication, minimizing signal loss, while multi-mode fibers serve shorter distances efficiently.
