

How to add a switch to fiber optic broadband

- Test the Connection:** Verify connectivity and speed between the switch and the main network.

Practical Considerations

- For short distances, multi-mode fiber is cost-effective and sufficient.
- Ensure matching connectors at both ends of the fiber.
- Avoid sharp bends in fiber cables to prevent signal loss.
- If extending to outbuildings, consider PoE switches if you need to power devices like cameras or access points.
- Fiber infrastructure is future-proof, allowing upgrades without replacing cables.
