Specialist Certifications: After CFOT, technicians can pursue additional certifications (CFOS) for specific skills like OSP installation, FTTH, or wireless applications . Other recognized certifications include ETA Broadband Fiber Technician (BFT), BICSI structured cabling certifications, and OTT Certified Optical Network Engineer (CONE), each tailored to different roles from field installation to network design and management . Key certifications include: ISO 9001 (Quality Management System): Ensures consistent manufacturing and testing practices . RoHS Compliance: Restricts hazardous substances like lead and mercury in cables, required for EU market access . REACH Compliance: Ensures safe use of chemicals throughout the supply chain .
