

How to clean fiber optic patch cords

Inspection Before Cleaning Always begin by turning off any laser sources and disconnecting the fiber from equipment. - Lint-free wipes:** Use cleanroom-quality wipes to gently wipe the fiber endface without scrubbing or reusing the same surface.
- Compressed air:** Can remove loose dust without direct contact, but avoid blowing moisture onto the fiber.

Wet Cleaning Techniques For stubborn contamination such as oils, fingerprints, or polishing residues:

- Apply a small amount of fiber optic cleaning solution to a lint-free wipe or swab.** Gently wipe the connector endface, then follow with a dry wipe to remove any remaining liquid.
- Ensure the cleaning solution does not leave residue, as this can damage the connector or degrade signal quality.**

Cleaning Multi-Fiber Connectors For MPO/MTP connectors: Use specialized multi-fiber cleaners that can clean multiple fibers simultaneously. Inspect each fiber after cleaning, as contamination can transfer between fibers when mated.

Re-Inspection and Best Practices Always inspect after cleaning to confirm the endface is free of contaminants. Repeat cleaning if necessary, following the Inspect-Clean-Inspect process. Dispose of used wipes, swabs, or cleaning tapes properly to prevent cross-contamination.
