

How to code the wires in a distribution box

Live (Phase) Wires: These carry current from the mains to the circuits. Circuit Breaker Connections

1P (Single-Pole) Breakers: Only the live wire passes through the breaker; the neutral bypasses it and connects directly to the neutral busbar.

2P (Double-Pole) Breakers: Both live and neutral wires pass through the breaker, disconnecting simultaneously when tripped.

RCD/Residual Current Devices: Require a PE connection to the ground busbar for earth fault protection.

Additional Notes

Color Coding by Region: Always verify local standards (IEC in Europe, NEC in the US, CEC in Canada) as older installations may use different colors.

Safety Precautions: Never rely solely on color; always test wires with a multimeter before handling.

Labeling: When mixing old and new wiring, label wires clearly to avoid misidentification.
