

How to connect NVR to the core switch

- Connect NVR to Core Switch:** Attach the NVR to the core switch using a dedicated Ethernet port. This allows the NVR to access all camera streams from the PoE switches without overloading other network segments.
- Configure Network Settings:** Assign IP addresses to cameras, PoE switches, and the NVR within the same subnet or VLAN. Ensure the NVR can discover all cameras and that bandwidth allocation prevents video drops.
- Test the System:** Verify live view and recording performance. Monitor for latency or dropped frames, especially if multiple high-resolution cameras are used.

Best Practices

- Dedicated VLAN for Surveillance:** Isolate camera traffic from general network traffic to prevent congestion.
- Sufficient Uplink Bandwidth:** Ensure the uplink...
