

How to connect a jumper cable to an optical module

Precautions Wear protective gloves and anti-static wristbands to prevent damage from fiber fragments or static electricity. Never pull on the cable boot; always use the latch mechanism to disengage the connector. Avoid suspending the jumper freely from the device to prevent breakage. Label fibers for polarity management and maintain proper bend radius throughout the installation.
