Connect the neutral wire to the neutral busbar and the earth wire to the earth busbar. Output Wiring: Connect each phase from the MCCB to the corresponding input terminals of the output MCBs via busbars. Ensure that only line terminals pass through the MCBs. RCCB (if used): Connect after the main MCCB, then route its output to the MCBs for additional protection against leakage currents. Neutral and Earth Distribution: Connect the neutral and earth busbars to the respective terminals of each MCB and load. Ensure all connections are tight and properly insulated.
