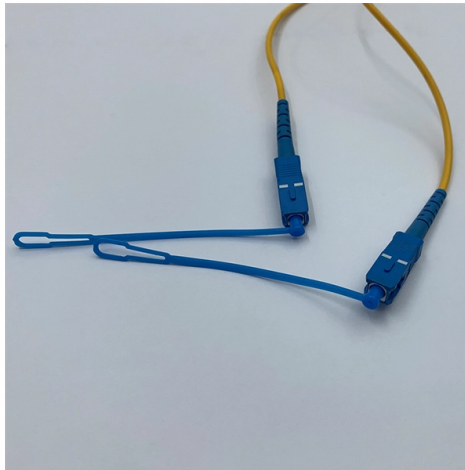


# How to connect fiber optic cable to a splice box

  - Mechanical splicing:** Aligns fibers using a mechanical device and index-matching gel, suitable for temporary or quick connections ( $\sim 0.3$  dB loss).
- Prepare fibers:** Strip the fiber coating, clean with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol, and cleave the fiber ends to create smooth, perpendicular surfaces.
- Align and splice:** For fusion splicing, place fibers in the splicer and fuse them; for mechanical splicing, insert fibers into the splice sleeve and ensure proper alignment.
- Protect the splice:** Use a splice protection sleeve or tray compartment to shield the joint from environmental damage.
