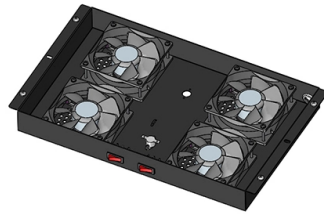


How to connect the fiber optic cable to the splice tray
