

How to connect the optical distribution box to the pipeline

Use nylon ties or cable organizers to secure the main trunk cables, while individual branch fibers may not require ties (). For drop cables, route them into the designated protection tubes or holders within the splice tray ().

Step 4: Splicing and Termination Strip the fiber ends and protect them with protection connectors if required (). Perform fusion splicing between the feeder fibers and pigtails or drop fibers, placing the splices in the splice tray (). Secure the spliced fibers under the tray cover to prevent mechanical impact and maintain signal integrity ().

Step 5: Final Connections and Testing Terminate the connectors at the adapter ports inside the ODB. If using patch cables, connect them to the appropriate adapters (). Organize excess fiber using zip...
