

How to connect the optical port of a switch to the electrical port

To connect an optical SFP port to an electrical RJ45 port, you need an SFP copper (electrical) module that converts the optical interface to a standard Ethernet interface.

How to Connect

- Common models include** ETU-Link ES-T1-R or similar copper SFP modules.
- Connect the Ethernet Cable:** Plug a Cat5e or Cat6 cable into the RJ45 port on the other switch or device. Connect the other end of the cable to the copper SFP module inserted in the SFP port. This setup enables full-duplex gigabit communication without additional configuration.

Combo Ports Consideration: Some switches have combo ports, which include both RJ45 and SFP interfaces sharing the same port number. Only one interface can be active at a time. If using the SFP with a copper module, ensure the RJ45 side is disabled or not in use.

Hybrid Cable Option (Optional): In specialized setups, hybrid optical-electrical cables can connect directly to hybrid switches, with the optical fiber going to the SFP port and the electrical line to the RJ45 port. This is more common in integrated optical-electrical switches and terminal boxes.
