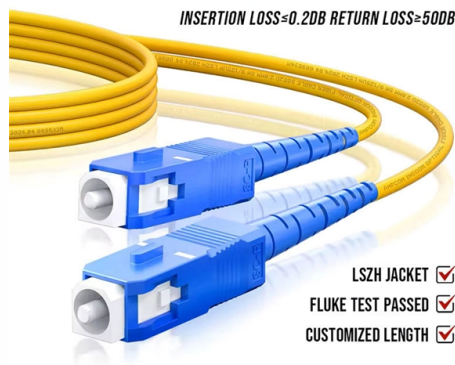


How to connect wires from the distribution box to electrical appliances

Connect the output of the Main MCB to the input of the RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) for protection against leakage currents and shocks.
- 4. Connect Outgoing Circuits** Connect each circuit wire to its corresponding MCB. Ensure phase wires go to the MCB input, neutral wires to the neutral link, and earth wires to the earth link. Label each wire clearly to indicate the circuit it serves, which helps in maintenance and troubleshooting.
- 5. Verify Connections** Use a multimeter to check for continuity, correct voltage, and absence of short circuits. Ensure all connections are tight and properly insulated to prevent loose connections or electrical hazards.
