

How to convert whole-house fiber optic internet to a router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN port.
- Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- Access the router's configuration interface (typically via 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to set up Wi-Fi, enable Quality of Service (QoS), and configure security settings.

Step 4: Optimize Whole-House Coverage

- Router placement:** Centralize the router to maximize Wi-Fi coverage.
- Mesh network:** For larger homes, consider adding mesh nodes to extend coverage.
- Firmware updates:** Keep the router and ONT firmware up to date for performance and security.
- Wired connections:** Use Ethernet for devices requiring maximum speed and low latency, such as gaming consoles or workstations.

Step 5: Troubleshooting Tips

- Ensure fiber connectors are properly seated; improper connections can reduce signal by over 30%.
