The first step is to check the product documentation or manufacturer's website. Most reputable manufacturers clearly label their products as "PoE" or "PoE+" if they support higher wattage. These sections provide information about the conditions required for a PoE capable switch to provide power, how the PoE-capable switch identify the power requirement of the powered device, and how PoE.
