

How to determine the height of a cable tray

Measuring Method

Identify the tray type: Ladder, perforated, channel, or wire mesh trays may have different side rail designs affecting height measurement. Use a tape measure or caliper: Measure vertically from the tray bottom to the top of the side rail. For ladder trays, measure to the top of the side rail; for wire mesh trays, measure to the highest mesh edge.

Consider usable depth: The usable depth may be slightly less than the total height due to cable placement and side rail thickness. This is the effective space for cable stacking.

Check against cable fill requirements: Calculate the total cable cross-sectional area and ensure it does not exceed the allowed fill percentage (commonly 40–50% of usable area) to maintain proper ventilation and safety.
