

How to directly plug fiber optic cable into a switch

- 6. Avoid Common Mistakes** Do not plug fiber into a standard Ethernet port; it requires an SFP module or media converter . Match single-mode fiber with single-mode SFPs and multi-mode fiber with multi-mode SFPs. Keep fiber ends clean to prevent signal loss or errors. Following these steps ensures a stable and functional fiber connection between your switch and other network devices .
