6. **Secure and Label Wires** If you need to work inside the box, label and secure all disconnected wires using electrical tape or wire connectors to prevent accidental contact.
7. **Follow Safety Precautions** Always wear appropriate protective gear, such as insulated gloves and safety glasses. Never assume a circuit is de-energized with...
