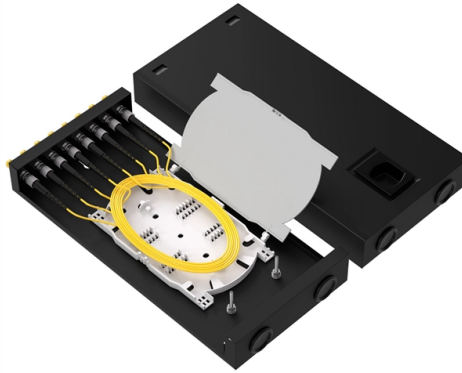


# How to encrypt a fiber optic router

**Router-Level Security Features** Modern fiber routers often include built-in firewalls, intrusion detection systems (IDS), and network monitoring tools. Wi-Fi Protected Access (WPA3) and Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) enhance wireless security. Some routers, like the NETGEAR Nighthawk Tri-Band WiFi 7, offer integrated security subscriptions for malware and identity protection.
