

How to find the power source of the distribution box

In larger distribution systems, the primary feeder may be a medium-voltage line connected to a transformer that steps down voltage for the secondary circuits ().
5. Verify with Electrical Parameters If safe and qualified, measure voltage at the main breaker terminals to confirm the active primary source. Always ensure proper safety precautions, as these conductors remain energized even when the breaker is off ().
6. Check for Labels and Diagrams Many distribution boxes include schematics or labels indicating the primary feeder, secondary circuits, and...
