

How to ground the network cabinet wiring



Overview

This is commonly accomplished with bonding the shielded hardware and shielded patch panel to AC ground, often via bonding the shielded patch panel to a rack mounted copper busbar (RBB) and that RBB is then further bonded to a SBB or PBB (secondary or primary busbar). Bonding (or grounding) is a system of protective measures, which is implemented to prevent electric shocks when touching metal parts of energy-powered equipment. The whole structure consists of a metal circuit, a protect bus, and a ground wire. Network hardware is connected to PDUs and constantly. If you're setting up a server rack, one of the most important things to consider is proper server rack grounding. ed grounding kits shall be UL Listed, CSA Certified and RoHS compliant. ll components shall be bonded to the rails with paint. If there is a wiring fault inside the device (frayed wire shorting against the metal inside), then the outer shell of the unit may be electrified. Guess what happens when you touch it?

Ouch! By having a ground path, you give the electrical current somewhere else to go (instead of through your body).
