 - Prevent kinks, knots, or twisting during installation, as these can increase attenuation or cause permanent damage ().

 - Ensure precise core alignment for singlemode fibers to minimize coupling loss. Transverse and angular alignment must be accurate ().
 - For multimode fibers, field termination is simpler, often using tight-buffered fibers with connectors installed directly ().
 - Maintain the total attenuation budget when joining fibers, especially when using bulkhead connectors ().

 - Inspect joints regularly for contamination or damage.
 - Use proper pulling techniques and avoid excessive tension during installation ().
