Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and correct wire gauge and breaker size. Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed with no visible gaps. Include protective devices such as circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors, with each circuit having its own protection.

Grounding and Safety Ground the metal box, electrical installation board, and all metal components inside the box. Connect the protective neutral wire reliably through the terminal board. Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use UL/CE-certified components.
