

How to install motor wiring in a distribution box

Motor Termination: Motor leads should be connected using mechanical or crimp compression lugs or split bolts. Connections using only solder or twist-on connectors are not recommended due to poor reliability. Each lug should be torqued according to NEC or manufacturer specifications, and anti-oxidant compounds can be applied to prevent corrosion and reduce resistance.

Parallel Leads: If multiple motor leads or power supply conductors are used, the lugs should have the same number of barrels as the number of leads, and bolts should be properly torqued. Belleville washers can help maintain torque when different metals are used.

Cable Routing and Organization

Wiring Direction: In the distribution box, wiring from the main circuit breaker to branch breakers is generally routed on the left, while outgoing wiring is on the right. Wires should be bound with plastic ties at uniform spacing to maintain neatness and prevent mechanical stress.

Shielding and Grounding: For motors driven by PWM drives, shielding is important to reduce electrical noise. Motor cable shields should be bonded at the motor frame, optionally at the panel entry, and at the drive chassis. Wide metal trays or solid steel conduits can help maintain a single ground plane an...
