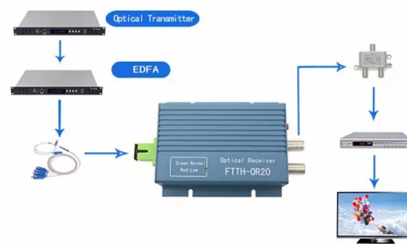


How to install the pigtail fusion sleeve

FIBER SPLICE CASSETTE

Splice the fiber pigtail to the corresponding color on the fiber cable (Figure 6 and 7). For splice protection, shrink 40mm splice sleeves in fusion splicer oven based on recommended procedure.
