

How to install the power distribution box for a surveillance camera

To connect a surveillance camera to a power distribution box, use the correct DC wiring, match positive and negative leads, and secure connections with a Siamese or plug-and-play cable. **Step-by-Step Guide**

1. Choose the Right Cable For analog cameras, use a Siamese coaxial cable that combines video and power wires. For IP cameras, you may use Cat5e/Cat6 Ethernet cables with PoE injectors if applicable . Ensure the cable length is sufficient to reach from the camera to the power box .

3. Connect the Camera to the Cable Attach the male DC power terminal from the cable to the camera's power pigtail or input . Connect the BNC connector (for analog cameras) to the camera's video input if using a Siamese cable .
4. Connect the Cable to the Power Distribution Box Strip the cable ends if necessary and attach the red and black leads to the corresponding screw-down terminals in the power box . If using a plug-and-play PT-3 lead, simply screw the labeled positive and negative wires into the power box terminals .
5. Mount and Power the Box Secure the power distribution box to a wall near your DVR or central location using anchors and screws . Plug the box into a standard AC outlet. Modern boxes may include PTC auto-reset fuses for surge protection, which automatically reset if overloaded .
6. Test the System Turn on the power box and verify that the camera powers up. Check the video feed to ensure proper connection. Inspect all wiring for secure connections and correct polarity. **Tips for Safety and Reliability** Always turn off the power before making connections. Use weatherproof junction boxes for outdoor cameras to protect wiring . Label cables for...
