

How to seal a horizontal optical cable splice box



Overview

Seal with Tape: Wrap self-adhesive sealing tape between the two sealing rings to align with the outer diameter of the rings, creating a sealed cable end. Secure the Cable: Insert the sealed cable end into the closure and use a hose clamp to secure the cable to the base of the splice.

1 Sealing of the fiber optic splice closure

(1) Clean the sealing groove around the joint box with alcohol cotton/wipes. The sealing strip should be tightly attached to the groove. (3) the unused fiber port. Preparing cables for splice closures involves several steps that should be followed in the exact sequence specified by the manufacturer to ensure the cables are properly secured with adequate strain relief and the closure will seal. The scope of application is: aerial, underground, pipeline, hand-holes. The ambient temperature ranges from -40 to 65°C.
