

# How to set up a router for fiber optic bridging

Connect a computer directly to the ONT/ONU via Ethernet. Open a web browser and enter the ONT/ONU's IP address to access its admin interface. Log in using the credentials provided by your ISP. Navigate to Network Settings, WAN, or Operation Mode and select Bridge Mode. Assign a specific LAN port (e.g., LAN1) for bridging if required. Save the settings and allow the ONT/ONU to reboot.

**Step 4: Connect Your Router**

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the router's WAN port to the designated LAN port on the ONT/ONU. Power on your router and wait for it to detect the internet connection. Configure the router using your ISP-provided credentials (often PPPoE) if necessary.

**Step 5: Configure Router Settings**

Disable the router's Wi-Fi if using a separate access point or mesh system. Enable Quality of Service (QoS) for VoIP or video streaming if needed. Verify that the router is handling DHCP, NAT, and firewall functions.
