Install branch circuit breakers in the subpanel for each localized circuit, such as lighting, outlets, or appliances ().

Step 5: Grounding Ensure the subpanel has a dedicated ground wire back to the main panel and, if required, connect to local ground rods (). This is critical for safety and code compliance.

Step 6: Final Checks Verify all connections are tight and properly insulated (). Label each breaker...
