These methods are effective for certain polyimide or specialty coatings but require careful handling to avoid fiber damage or chemical hazards. Thermal strippers can be diameter-adjustable to accommodate different fiber sizes, providing flexibility for multi-layer cables. Laser-Based Stripping Laser stripping is a contact-free, highly precise method suitable for ultra-high reliability applications. A focused laser beam removes acrylate or polyimide coatings by forming grooves in the protective layers, which are then split and removed without touching the fiber. Laser stripping allows for end or window stripping, precise dimensional control, and residue-free fiber surfaces, making...
