Connect the Fibers: Insert the fiber into the designated openings in the box. Use splice trays or adapters to connect the incoming fiber to pigtails or outgoing fibers according to the manufacturer's instructions. Label each connection for future reference.

Organize Excess Fiber: Coil any extra fiber neatly in the storage area of the box to prevent kinks or tangles.
