Installation Steps

Placement: Mount the splitter in a secure location, such as a wall or rack, ensuring it is protected from physical damage and excessive bending of fibers.

Connecting the Input: Connect the uplink fiber from your Main FTTR or ONT to the splitter's input port using the SC/APC connector. Ensure the connector clicks securely to avoid signal loss.

Connecting the Outputs: Connect each output port to a Sub FTTR device or another splitter if cascading is needed. Use the ATB box to store excess fiber length and prevent bending or damage.

Cascading Splitters: If more than four sub-devices are required, use the cascade port on the first splitter to connect a second splitter, effectively expanding the network to 16 outputs.

Fiber Management: Use plane corner clips, wall-through cable supporters, or external/internal corner clips to secure fibers along walls and corners, preventing stress on the connectors.

Operational Notes

Passive Device: The splitter does not require power; it simply divides the optical signal.

Signal Loss: Each split introduces some attenuation, so plan splitter placement to minimize long fiber runs and maintain gigabit performance.

Compatibility: Ensure the splitter is compatible with your Huawei FTTR version (F50 Standard or Plus) or G...
