Overview

Have a cable clamp for each one and loosen the screws to open the collar. This technique is often necessary when repairing a damaged section of wiring or when extending an existing circuit to reach a new location. There are many ways to splice wires together, from using wire caps to soldering them together. A junction box is usually square.
